

# GALLE CITY TOUR

*(One Day)*

DAY 01 - (22.09.2017)

08.00 a.m. - Proceed to Galle after Breakfast



Galle - It is close to the island's southernmost point and has the distinction of being the best-preserved sea fort in South Asia. It is a living heritage site, with a splendid blend of architecture, that resemble those in the coastal areas of Portugal. You can view many colonial buildings remaining within the ramparts and stonewalls of the old Galle Fort, perhaps the most absorbing is the Dutch Reformed Church.

12.30 p.m. – Lunch at Galle Light House Hotel



02.15 p.m. - Boat Ride along Madhu River

**Madhu River** (Madhu Ganga) – It is a river lagoon which encompasses a 915-hectare water body, inclusive of 30-odd islands, situated off Balapitiya in southern Sri Lanka. You can view the villagers fishing, visit the old Buddhist temple and stop by the cinnamon islands.

04.30 p.m. - Visit a Turtle Hatchery in Kosgoda

19.30 p.m. - Check-in to the Hotel in Colombo
